The hall is of brick, has a Victorian Gothic character, and is in a dominant position in the centre of the village. It is dated 1885 and was built as a boys school, the girls remaining in a smaller building in Quarry Lane. Previously the site was occupied by the Ring o' Bells public house. The building (with an additional classroom) served as a primary school until 1974, ramped access and other facilities being added in 1997.
